GRANT OF EXPLORATION LICENCE 9224 NEAR BROKEN HILL IN NSW




Figure 1: Location of Company's granted tenements near Broken Hill showing the key Prospects.

Ausmon Resources Limited ("Company") is pleased to announce that its wholly owned subsidiary New Base Metals Pty Ltd has been granted exploration licence EL 9224 Eureka for 5 years to 21 July 2026. This latest grant follows from the grant of EL 9220 and EL 9230 earlier this week and brings the total number of exploration licences granted to the Company in the Broken Hill area to 5 (see Figure 1).

The aim of the Company is to explore for Broken Hill-type Pb-Zn-Ag, Iron Oxide Cu-Au (IOCG) and Cobalt mineralisation within Palaeoproterozoic Willyama Supergroup rocks as found by Cobalt Blue in their tenements. Preparation for a detailed exploration program near Broken Hill is underway for implementation this year.




Figure 2: Granted EL 9220 Enmore and EL 9224 Eureka on outcrop geology (Broken Hill 1:250,000 metallogenic map sheet)

The Willyama Super Group comprises poorly outcropping (**Figure 2**), medium to high grade regionally metamorphosed and strongly deformed sedimentary, volcanic and intrusive rocks. The Palaeoproterozoic sequence has been intruded by extensive volumes of Mesoproterozoic granitoids and scattered mafic dykes. Recent river alluvium and Quaternary sediments (shades of yellow in **Figure 2**) occur extensively across the granted tenements resulting in limited historic surficial geochemical exploration and subsequent drilling.
