2 Section B: Community Consultation

Exploration Licence (EL) 8747 is located 10 km's north west of Broken Hill to the north of the Barrier Highway, Exploration is managed by Ausmon Resources.

The Company completed a 10 hole RC drilling program in the reporting period on Stirling Vale Station located in the south east of the EL 8747 in full consultation with the station owner.

All 10 RC drill holes have been fully rehabilitated, and a rehabilitation report was submitted to the NSW Resource Regulator. All rubbish was removed to the satisfaction of the landowner who assisted with track repairs so as to facilitate the drilling program.

3 Section C: Details of any Consultation Undertaken

An access agreement has been signed with Stirling Vale station shown in brown in Figure 2 on which most of the licence is located. A meeting was held was held with the station owner Geoff Hodgins in Broken Hill to discuss the proposed drilling program and the program was agreed to. Geoff offered to repair an existing track to facilitate drill rig access. An access agreement is yet to be finalised with Thackaringa Station (**Figure 2**). A meeting was held with David Lord at Thackaringa Station to discuss access to the Porcupine Prospect Area for preliminary exploration. It was agreed that the Company could access the area for a 5 day period to carry out preliminary exploration prior to entering into a formal access agreement.

3.1 Authority Location




Figure 1: EL8747 showing location relative to Broken Hill




Figure 2: EL8747 showing all pastoral properties, Stirling Vale station in brown

Exploration Licence (EL) 8747 is located 10 km's north west of Broken Hill and to the north of the Barrier Highway. in western NSW (**Figure 1**). Exploration is managed by Ausmon Resources. It consists of 45 units and is situated primarily on Stirling Vale Station (figure 2).
